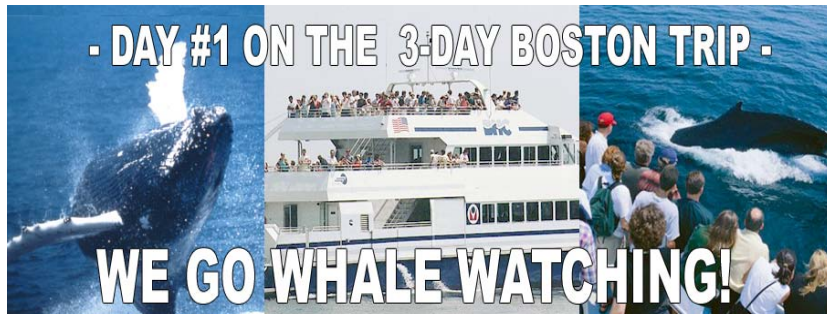


# WE'RE GOING to BOSTON this summer!

## DAY 1

**We go Whale Watching!** - After we get settled in at the hotel we'll head to the New England Aquarium and board the Voyager III for Boston's best whale watching expedition! Our destination is the Stellwagen Bank Marine Sanctuary, a well-known feeding ground for whales, including humpback whales, finback whales, minke whales, as well as pilot whales and even the endangered northern right whales. It's also an area filled

with dolphins, sea birds and other marine life. It's an amazing and breathtaking sight!

After whale watching we head back to the hotel and relax, go for a dip in the pool, and then get ready for our 16th Annual 3-Day Trip Pizza Party!



## DAY 2

**We go to the Six Flags New England Amusement Park! The BEST amusement park in New England!**

We'll spend the entire day at Six Flags which features eight great coasters including "Bizarro - Ride of Steel". "Bizarro" has been **ranked as the #1 coaster in the US by World Magazine**. It's also a recipient of the Amusement Today Golden Ticket Award ranking **as one of the top steel roller coasters in the world!!!** If the coasters and thrill

rides aren't enough, check out the incredible water park! Six Flags features all the standard water rides plus super water amusements like the Big Kahuna, the Typhoon "Water Coaster", and the amazing Starburst Tornado! The Starburst Tornado is a spectacular adventure ride that drops seven stories into a 60-foot-tall, 132-foot-long water funnel filled with 5,000 gallons of churning water! **We tour Boston!** - Starting in the morning we'll tour some of Boston's best-known historic sites. Then we'll visit **Fenway Park** stadium, home of the Boston Red Sox. You'll get a behind the scenes look at Fenway Park... Touch the Green Monster! Visit the Press Box! See where Babe Ruth got his professional start! After Fenway, we take the **Duck Tour of Boston!** This amphibious vehicle will take us to the golden-domed State House, Bunker Hill, the TD Bank Garden, Boston Common, Copley

Square, the Big Dig, Government Center, Newbury Street, Quincy Market, the Prudential Tower, and more. Then we splash into the Charles River for a breathtaking view of the Boston and Cambridge skylines! The Duck Tour is AWESOME!

# Camper Agreement for the 3 Day Trip

Trip attendees and their parents are required to read and agree to the Trip Rules and Regulations printed below. This agreement must be signed by the camper and one of his/her parents before the camper can be scheduled to attend the trip.

1. All rules and regulations applicable in camp apply on this trip.
2. Campers are representatives of the camp and are expected to behave and conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively upon the camp. Campers who have presented behavior problems will not be allowed to attend the trip.
3. Campers are required to wear an official gray Camp Lohikan T-Shirt when attending the amusement park. (No exceptions can be made to this regulation.) A Camp Lohikan shirt (any Lohikan shirt will do) must be worn when participating in the Whale Watch, touring Fenway Park Stadium, and while on the Duck Boat Tour. If the camper doesn't have an extra Lohikan t-shirt, the camper will have to purchase one before departing on the trip. Camp shirts are not required to be worn when the camper is in the hotel.
4. Ipods and MP3 players are permitted only on the bus and in the hotel. (Make sure your name is on it.)
5. The telephones located in the hotel rooms are off limits. No one is permitted to use a room phone for any reason. (i.e. calling another room, room service, calling home.) Pay phones are located in the hotel and are available for use at the following times:
  - a) First Day until 9:30 pm.
  - b) Second Day in the morning. Campers can use the pay phones located at the amusement park the entire second day, but cannot use the pay phones in the hotel after we return the second night.
  - c) Third Day in the morning. Campers can use pay phones located at the Fenway Park Stadium, if time permits.
  - d) Please note that campers are not permitted to use pay phones at any restaurant or rest stop on this trip. The telephone rules and TV rules (#6) will be strictly enforced.
6. Televisions are located in the rooms and can be watched until curfew. Pay channels are off-limits. If a pay channel is charged to your room, telephone charges are made to your room or your room is damaged in any way, all individuals assigned to the room will be required to pay for the damage unless the person responsible is identified. That person will be dealt with accordingly.
7. The curfew is as follows:
  - a) First Night Curfew - 11:00pm
  - b) Second Night Curfew – as soon as we get back from the amusement park (approx. 10:30pm)
  - c) Third Night Curfew - When we arrive back at camp or the camper's normal curfew, whichever is later.
8. Campers are required to be in their assigned rooms at the established curfew. On the first night, after 9:30pm, campers are restricted to the floor on which their room is located. (This means campers are prohibited from entering the lobby and other floors after 9:30pm.) There will be other guests in the hotel and hotel management has requested that we keep the noise down in the hallways and lobby after 9:30pm. At 11:00pm room lights and televisions are required to be turned off.
- 9. No one is permitted to leave his or her room after curfew. This is grounds for dismissal from camp without a refund.**
10. Boys are not allowed in a girl's room at any time. No girls are permitted in a boy's room at any time.
11. No one is permitted to leave the hotel or leave any tour site (amusement park, restaurants, museums, etc.) without a Senior Staff Member.
12. When at the amusement park or on a tour, all campers must buddy up with at least 2 other campers at all times. Traveling in groups of less than 3 campers is prohibited.
13. Campers are required to wear a watch at all times. Meeting at scheduled check-in times is the responsibility of the camper.
14. Trip attendees are limited to one small suitcase or one small duffel bag. All bags must be clearly marked with your name and marked with the name Camp Lohikan. (Camp will provide baggage tags.)
15. No food or drinks are permitted on the bus.
16. Any behavioral incident involving park management, hotel security or police will preclude the camper from attending further camp trips. A phone call home will be made and depending upon the facts, the incident may result in the camper's expulsion from camp without a refund.
17. Violation of rules #1 through #11 will prevent the camper's participation in all further camp trips (Hershey Park, Binghamton Mets). Any violation of rules #1, #5, #6, #7, #8, #9, and #10 will result in a phone call home and disciplinary action.
18. A violation of any significant camp rules and/or rules #8, #9 or #10 will result in the camper's dismissal from camp without a refund of tuition.
19. The parent understands and acknowledges that his/her child's participation in Camp Lohikan's 3 Day Trip Program and its activities is completely voluntary and the parent has familiarized himself/herself with the camp's program and activities in which his/her child will be participating.

The parent recognizes that certain dangers are inherent in the camp's trip program and particularly, but not limited to, the activity of traveling and touring, and the parent acknowledges that although Camp Lohikan has taken safety measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants, Camp Lohikan cannot ensure nor guarantee that the participants, equipment, premises and/or activities will be free of hazards, accidents and/or injuries. The parent further recognizes and has instructed his/her child in the importance of knowing and abiding by the camp's rules, regulations and procedures for the safety of camp trip participants.
